BROCKVILLE CHURCHES

- FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH
 - 10 CHURCH ST.
 - FOUNDED IN 1811, CURRENT CHURCH ERECTED IN 1896
 - WAS THE FIRST CHURCH TO BE BUILT IN BROCKVILLE, BUT THE ORIGINAL WAS DESTROYED BY A FIRE IN 1847
 - LAND WAS ORIGINALLY DONATED BY BROCKVILLE'S FOUNDER WILLIAM BUELL
- ST. PAUL'S ANGLICAN CHURCH
 - 12 PINE ST.
 - THE CHURCH WAS ERECTED IN 1840, BUT THE PARISH ON THE EAST SIDE WAS NOT ADDED UNTIL 1891
 - IT WAS DESIGNED BY L.G. HOWARD OF TORONTO, UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF BENJAMIN CHAFFEY JR.
- ST. JOHN'S UNITED CHURCH
 - 32 PARK ST.
 - FOUNDED IN 1835

BROCKVILLE CHURCHES

- FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH
 - 5 PINE ST.
 - FOUNDED IN 1844
- THOUSAND ISLANDS BAPTIST CHURCH
 - 229 PARK ST.
- SEVENTH DAY ADVENTIST CHURCH
 - 100 PERTH ST.
- BROCKVILLE WESLEYAN CHURCH
 - 33 CENTRAL AVE. WEST
 - FOUNDED IN 1957
- WALL STREET UNITED CHURCH
 - 5 WALL ST.
 - BUILT IN 1830
- ST. LAWRENCE ANGLICAN CHURCH
 - 80 PINE ST.
 - FOUNDED IN 1814
- ST. FRANCIS XAVIER CHURCH
 - 66 CHURCH ST.
 - ESTABLISHED IN 1821
